PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Hall. The question now is, shall the Chair be overruled? All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? A record vote has been requested.

SENATOR HALL: (Mike not turned on immediately.) ...the house, and a roll call vote.

PRESIDENT MOUL: We have a request for a call of the house. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 23 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The house is under call. All unexcused senators please return to the Chambers and record their presence. All unauthorized personnel must leave the floor. Would the senators please check in. The house is under call. Senator Abboud, Senator Moore, would you please check in. Senator Byars, Senator Chambers, Senator Dierks, Senator Haberman, please check in. Senator Hefner and Senator Rod Johnson, please check in. Still looking for Senators Haberman, Dierks, Byars and Senator Abboud. A roll call vote has been requested and the question is, shall the Chair be overruled? Please proceed, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote. See page 1124 of the Legislative Journal.) 13 ayes, 29 nays, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The motion fails and I will raise the call. We'll proceed with opening by Senator Warner on this section. Senator Haberman.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Point of personal privilege, please, Madam Chairman. I would like to question the germaneness of Section 179 on page 6. It states any purchaser of depreciable agricultural machinery and equipment purchased on or after January, 1992 for use in commercial agriculture may apply. Rule 7 says any amendment, a nongermane amendment includes one that relates to a substantially different subject. I have gone completely through 1063 and I can find no reference whatsoever and the words aren't even mentioned of commercial agriculture.
