

**SPEAKER BAACK:** Thank you, Senator Warner. Anyone else wishing to discuss this portion of the amendment? Senator Schmit.

**SENATOR SCHMIT:** Mr. President and members, I just want to make a point, that is that I believe we adopted the previous amendment by 15 to 5 votes, or something of that nature. I want to go on record as saying I think it is a travesty that we have 15 or 20 people on this floor passing amendments to the Constitution, which we have not seen before, and which we don't understand, and I don't, I will be very frank, and I do not understand, and which in a short period of time, one of my colleagues will come back from the pizza feast and will vote on the amended version of the constitutional amendment and expect the voters to know what they are voting about. And then we will wonder why the court looks upon us like a bunch of school children, I might add, very small and young school children. And I think that we ought to get the people here and discuss this and have everyone know what is going on. I think Senator Warner would agree with me on that.

**SPEAKER BAACK:** Thank you, Senator Schmit. Anyone else wishing to discuss this portion of the amendment? Seeing no one, Senator Warner, did you wish to close?

**SENATOR WARNER:** Again, Mr. President, members of the Legislature, as I have tried to indicate several times, this is to ensure that a separate class shall automatically be authorized in our State Constitution, so that when the federal government takes action and restricts what the state can do in its system of classification, it does not wash over into other property which was not dealt with at the federal level and makes the federally things, which would be the case anyway, those would be a separate class because of federal legislation, but it is to prevent that being utilized by some property owners in this state to piggyback.

**SPEAKER BAACK:** Thank you, Senator Warner. You've heard the closing. We will now vote on this portion of the amendment. We are on the second portion of the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the second portion of the amendment, have you all voted? Senator Hall.
