SENATOR CHAMBERS: Then, Senator Hillman, what I would like the amendment to do is be placed at the three places in the bill where this language occurs, because I was just talking to Senator Kristensen and he had indicated on the application for the identification card it's the same thing.

SENATOR HILLMAN: Right.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So I would want to make it clear that the amendment deals with...Senator Kristensen is kind of helping me here. Mr. Clerk, can I give you this so it will be written onto the amendment?

CLERK: I'll try, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, the same language would appear also...you won't have to rewrite what it says, just another location.

CLERK: Uh, huh.
