

Vehicles is in no way put into position where they answer questions. All they do is provide the information and see that the person, the applicant, has information to look at. The other thing that is going to be done and I heard Senator Chambers talk about the age is which I think he has a concern with them not understanding or feeling that some way that filling out this form is going to be connected with whether or not they receive a driver's license. When the new driver's license manual is printed there will be a part in the driver's in the rules and regs that will explain the application and will inform anyone reading the driver's manual of what is involved and what is entailed here. The other thing that happens that I think is really important with this particular bill, and though it may seem like an insignificant thing, it's the image on the front of the driver's license that will indicate that this person wants to be a donor and I say that because the driver's license today is used in identification, cash checks, all kinds of areas a driver's license is considered that piece of identification that is accepted and you flash that, you use that driver's license over and over and over again when you show it to many, many people. What you're doing when you choose to be a donor with this image that will be on the front is that you're telling people that this is what your wishes are. In my estimation you are helping the donor program. You are saying, I'm going to do this. In other areas I know people have asked questions about it when they've seen it. They noted it and it's a good way to get the information out and to get the program supported, and yes, that's a reason to do it. It is to get support for the program. It is to get more people to go on a donor's list. It is to get more involvement. It is to help more people. So the line that Senator Chambers talks about though people have a choice, they will know they have a choice, nothing is mandated, nothing is going to be told them they have to do. I don't think it's necessary. Senator Chambers thinks it is, so I'll leave it up to the body whether or not they want to include it on the application. I will not object to the amendment.
