CLERK: 17 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The house is under call. Would all unexcused senators please return to the chambers and record their presence. All unauthorized personnel must leave the floor. Welcome, Dr. Blankenau, and thank you. Senator Lamb is on his way. Would you like us to proceed, Senator Robinson? We'll proceed with roll call vote.
