tax, all business tax that would be paid. That's a fair proposal. That's one that the voters can support.

SPEAKER BAACK: Time.

SENATOR HALL: I would urge adoption of the amendment. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Hall. Senator Schellpeper, you're next.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Thank you, Mr. Speaker and members, I'd like to ask Senator Hall a question if I might.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Hall, would you respond, please.

SENATOR HALL: Yes.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Senator, have you ever looked at, with this \$90 million, how that breaks out between business and agriculture and homeowners like we have all the other bills we've been debating here for the last two weeks?

SENATOR HALL: Senator Schellpeper, you mean the sector by sector...?

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Yes, yes.

SENATOR HALL: You know, this is the first amendment I haven't done that on and it wasn't intentional. We'll do that. We can probably have that before, well, not before you're done speaking, but before I close.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Do you think that...?

SENATOR HALL: I can tell you that the...if you look at the repair labor,...

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Yes.

SENATOR HALL: ...ten million of that would be individual. The balance of it falls either to ag or business and you know the bulk of it would be in business. You'd have some ag in the repair because repair includes both ag, and ag, business and individual repair. The...let's see, you go down to some of the
