PRESIDENT MOUL: Okay. Do you have items for the record, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Lindsay would like to print amendments to LB...LR 219. That's all that I have. (See page 1253 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. You've heard the motion to adjourn. We will have a machine vote. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 6 ayes, 11 nays to adjourn.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The motion fails. We'll return to debate. Senator Withem, followed by Senator Schmit, Senator Dierks, and Senator Hall. Senator Withem.

SENATOR WITHEM: I would call the question.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Do I see sufficient seconds? I do. We'll now vote on the motion to cease debate. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the motion to cease debate? Senator Withem.

SENATOR WITHEM: Call of the house, reverse order roll call vote.

PRESIDENT MOUL: We have a request for call of the house. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 17 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The house is under call. Would all unexcused senators please return to the Chamber and record their presence. All unauthorized personnel must leave the floor. Would the senators please check in, the house is under call. Senator Conway, Senator Coordsen, please check in. Senator Warner, Senator Wesely, Senator Will. Senator Rasmussen and Senator Robinson, please check in. Still looking for Senator Robinson. We'll proceed with roll call vote in reverse order. We are voting on ceasing debate.
