PRESIDENT MOUL: One minute.

SENATOR SCHMIT: We are scuttling a plan which has been in place for 25 years, which has progressively moved towards the taxation of less property and more support from sales tax and income taxes, and we have now taken a step with 1013...1063 to scuttle that. I ask you to support the amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Schmit. We'll now vote on the Schmit amendment to LB 1063. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk. Yes, Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Madam President, I want to change my vote from aye to not voting for purposes of reconsideration.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Schmit, we'll have to go under call in order to accept that change.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I'll withdraw that motion then.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Okay.

CLERK: 6 ayes, 13 nays on adoption of the amendment, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The Schmit amendment fails.

CLERK: Madam President, I have a priority motion that would be to adjourn. It's offered by Senator Will. He would move to adjourn until March 10, 1992 at 9:00 a.m.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Okay. Are there any items for the record?

CLERK: I have nothing to read in, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Okay. You've heard the motion to adjourn. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. We are adjourned until 9:00 a.m. tomorrow morning.
