

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, to go under call.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The house is under call. Would all unexcused senators please return to the Chambers and record their presence. All unauthorized personnel must leave the floor. Would the senators please check in. The house is under call. Senator Lindsay, Senator Lynch, please check in. Senator Elmer, Senator Peterson, Senator Robak, Senator Robinson. Senator Rogers, Senator Hartnett. We're looking for Senators Robak, Morrissey and Lynch. We will proceed with a roll call vote on the motion to overrule the Chair.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 1270-71 of the Legislative Journal.) 8 ayes, 34 nays on the motion to overrule the Chair, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The motion fails and we will immediately go into the vote now on cloture. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. We have a request for a roll call, so we will proceed with roll call.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 1271-72 of the Legislative Journal.) 33 ayes, 7 nays on the motion for cloture, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The motion is approved and we'll immediately go into a vote on advancement of LB 1063.

CLERK: Madam President, I have a motion on the desk. Senator Moore would move to reconsider action on the previous motion pursuant to Rule 7, Section 7.

PRESIDENT MOUL: I have to deal with Senator Moore's point of order first. Okay, it is a motion to reconsider, yes.

SENATOR LINDSAY: My point of order is that you have called...we have moved immediately to the vote, you have called the vote. Any motions at this point are out of order. I ask that the Chair rule Senator Moore's motion at this point out of order.

PRESIDENT MOUL: I will rule that your motion is out of order. We have had the cloture...okay, we have a motion to overrule the Chair. Would you like to open, Senator Moore? Senator Withem.
