SPEAKER BAACK: Yes, Madam President and colleagues, I know that everyone is getting tired but we cannot adjourn yet. We have got to stay here and we are going to start to work on the constitutional amendment because we have to stay here until the bill is returned to us from the Bill Drafters Office and it is correctly engrossed. We have to have that bill tonight yet. So we will continue with debate on LR 219.

PRESIDENT MOUL: I did raise the call, Senators. Okay, we will proceed with LR 219. Mr. Clerk. We will stand at ease for about two minutes. We will proceed with LR 219.

CLERK: Madam President, 219, the first item are Enrollment and Review amendments.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Madam President, I move adoption of the E & R amendments.
