Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 19 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of LR 258.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LR 258 is adopted. Proceed with General File, LB 291A.

CLERK: Madam President, 291A introduced by Senator Beyer. (Read title.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Beyer.

SENATOR BEYER: Madam President and colleagues, LB 291 is sitting on Select File. We have to have 291A moved over to keep up with it. Basically, it's a transfer of money from the Department of Roads...or the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund over. And it's basically a revenue neutral bill with the fiscal note that I've got, the money that comes in from the passage of 291. So with that, I would ask your adoption...or the movement of the A bill over to Select File.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Beyer. Does anyone wish to speak to this bill? Seeing none, we will now vote on the motion to advance LB 291A. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted on the motion to advance LB 291A? Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of LB 291A.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 291A is advanced. LB 306A.

CLERK: LB 306A, introduced by Senator Beutler. (Read title.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Madam President and members of the Legislature, LB 306 is on Select File and so we are merely moving 306A up to get it up with the main bill. It has a fiscal note on it for 31,000, \$32,000, roughly, for '92-93, and 26,000 for '93-94, which would go basically to anticipated increased hearing costs related to the resolution of applications for instream flows for the water wells for the public entities. Would move the advancement of the bill.
