LB 306A, 428A, 922

Senator Rogers, please check in. Senator Landis, please check in. Looking for Senator Hartnett. Would the senators please return to their seats so that we can proceed with roll call vote. We will proceed with the roll call vote on the motion to advance LB 306A. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 1281-82 of the Legislative Journal.) 22 ayes, 5 nays, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The motion to advance fails. I will raise the call. Proceed now with LB 428A.

CLERK: Madam President, 428A by Senator Kristensen. (Read title.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Byars.

SENATOR BYARS: Yes, I will handle that for Senator Kristensen this morning, Madam President. LB 428A, as you know, is a utilization review bill establishing national standards for medical reviews in the State of Nebraska. Basically, the A bill is a cash funded bill with an expenditure of just over 32,000 the first year and 24,000 the second year. It requires fees into the Cash Fund that will basically balance this. And I would ask the advancement of 428A.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Byars. Does anyone wish to address this bill? Seeing none, we will now vote on the motion to advance LB 428A. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the motion to advance LB 428A? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of 428A.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 428A is advanced. Proceed now with Select File, LB 922.

CLERK: LB 922, Madam President, discussed briefly yesterday. The first motion I have to the bill this morning is by Senator Robinson. Senator Robinson's amendment is on page 1234 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Robinson.
