

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Conway. Senator Wesely, followed by Senator Haberman. Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Yes, Madam President, members. Senator Conway and I have discussed this, and I certainly do support the amendment. I think it's clarifying a number of problems we have in our statutes. And I would ask the body to adopt this amendment.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Madam President, members of the body, Senator Conway, would you yield to a couple questions, please.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Conway.

SENATOR CONWAY: Yes, sir.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Is there a penalty in LB 424?

SENATOR CONWAY: Is there what, Senator?

SENATOR HABERMAN: A penalty if it's not...if the law isn't followed?

SENATOR CONWAY: Is there a penalty in 424? Ah...

SENATOR HABERMAN: You're amending what into 424?

SENATOR CONWAY: Basically, several provisions, but primarily LB 977, which is the election cleanup bill.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Which is, what is it, though? Is it according to petition drives?

SENATOR CONWAY: It is...addresses petition drives, it addresses literally...

SENATOR HABERMAN: But you're amending that into 424, you're not gutting it, you're just amending it in there?

SENATOR CONWAY: Right, right, it's an addition to 424.
