

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: That's my...that is what I am trying to find.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: And that I don't think is Senator Lindsay's intentions. His intentions is to set a standard that is in-between the most difficult and the very bottom level, and the bottom level is whatever 25 people say. I don't think that is what the Legislature wants to do either, is that whatever 25 people say will occur. You want some protection of things that were done this year. There is a little higher standard. Now the higher standard is what I am going to propose to you in a little bit as soon as it gets down from bill drafters, which I think meets both sides' needs is that you...

PRESIDENT MOUL: Time.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. Senator Schmit, followed by Senators Landis, Lynch, Withem, and Kristensen. Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Madam President and members, I think that some of the questions that have been raised by Senators Moore and Wehrbein are of deep concern to all of us, and my deep concern about 219CA is just exactly what they have expressed, and that is that we are trying to place into the Constitution language which is far too definitive, and by doing so, we are going to erase the possibility for any future examples of limitations of taxation on personal property. I am concerned because it always appears to me that once we change direction, it is like a ship, you don't change the thing back very rapidly. We have thus far done a 180 degree turn, and the aircraft carrier is heading the other direction, and so for any attempt to be successful to remove farm equipment in the future from the tax rolls is going to be a superhuman effort in an increasingly hostile environment. But I want to ask the question, and I asked it several days ago, and Senator Withem is here?

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Withem.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Senator Withem, you are familiar with the bill. What is the procedure for amending the Constitution if 219CA passes or the statute? What has to be done statutorily? What can be done statutorily to either increase the various types of
