

SPEAKER BAACK: One minute.

SENATOR SCHMIT: ...our position on this, we will find that we have made an error. We have been absolutely immovable in attempting to provide some degree of equity between the 775 amendments that are locked in by contract and otherwise and the inventory exemptions which are locked in the Constitution. We refuse to lock in agricultural inventory and agricultural machinery. Ladies and gentlemen, I'll take my chances with this amendment. I want a record vote on this amendment to LB 219CA. Thank you, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Moore, would you record your presence, please. Senator Cudaback, would you record your presence, please. A record vote has been requested and we will now vote on the amendment offered by Senator Schmit. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. This is a record vote. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk. A roll call vote has been requested. Mr. Clerk, call the roll.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote. See page 1299 of the Legislative Journal.) 20 ayes, 25 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: The motion fails.

SENATOR CONWAY PRESIDING

SENATOR CONWAY: Mr. Clerk. The call is raised.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next motion I have on LR 219 is by Senator Baack. Speaker Baack would move to suspend Rule 6, Section 5, Rule 7 Section 3 and vote on final passage of LR 219, and vote, I'm sorry, vote on passage of 219 to E & R for engrossment.

SENATOR CONWAY: Thank you. Senator Baack.

SENATOR BAACK: Yes, Mr. Chairman and colleagues, this is the very first time I've ever made this motion. I've never been one to shut off debate in this body, but I think that we are under some very severe deadlines in this body and I think that the time has come that we provide for the vote to vote this on Select File and vote it over to E & R final and so that we will be ready tomorrow to consider both LB 1063 and LR 219 on Final
