SENATOR BAACK: Yes, Mr. Chairman and colleagues, this will be a very, very brief closing. This is not a motion that I file easily. I have never, never filed this motion before. I've never been one that votes to cease debate in this body, but in my position as Speaker I feel like we have to at times have to do things procedurally to make the body keep moving along and make us meet the deadlines that we have to meet. That's why I filed the motion. I am not a turncoat as Senator Chambers is calling me here. It's just one of those things that I felt that I needed to do at this point and I felt that the people who wanted to discuss the advancement of the bill could do that on this motion but we would preclude any other amendments from being put before the body. I would hope that you would support the suspension of the rules and then support the advancement of LR 219. Thank you.
