PRESIDENT MOUL: One minute.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: ...and how I felt watching that debate on TV, that I don't...don't think I can go with the CA. I guess, the long-term implications and the feeling of giving up, of lying down, I can't do it, I won't. Consider the effects politically, if I have to fall on the sword, I have to fall on the sword politically. But I won't go quietly, I'll just...I can't swallow it. Thank you.
