SPEAKER BAACK: Yes, Madam President and colleagues. I am having passed out right now a communication from the Governor that he sent around, if it's not initialed he just gave it to me, and I'm having that passed around right now. First of all, I'd like to congratulate the body, I think they've done some good work on this issue. I know that not all of us agree on the issue, but I think that we have done some...some very good work in the past couple of weeks. I think that the...the perception of the Legislature will be better because we have acted on this issue. And I want to congratulate each and every one of you for the work that we have done on this issue. With that, I would move that we adjourn until Tuesday morning at 9:00 a.m.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Speaker Baack. Senator Schmit, did you have a point of order?

SENATOR SCHMIT: Yes, I do, Madam Chairman. I suggest that...thank the Governor for his communication. I'd suggest that he order up a couple orders of broccoli, because a couple gentlemen want to eat broccoli. Thank you very much. (Laughter.)
