PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Wesely. We will now vote on the Wesely amendment to the committee amendments. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the Wesely amendment? Have you all voted? I might remind the senators that since we are voting on an appropriations bill that it does require 25 votes for an amendment to an amendment. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of Senator Wesely's amendment to the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment to the amendment is adopted. Further amendment, Mr. Clerk.

And that's \$147,000 for Region V Mental Health Facilities. And what I want to say to you about this is the Region V funding problems developed because they are...they have such...so many clients in Lincoln, Lancaster County and in this region, the southeast area, the southeast region. We have a lot of clients, we have a lot of people come here because the services are available. And they did have a lot more than \$147,000 that they needed, but we have gotten it
