

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Schellpeper. Senator Beutler, you are next.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Hefner, if I may, just a couple of questions. I am trying to remember back to LB 291 and some things we were trying to do there with respect to the provision that is on page 9 of LB 872, and that particular provision has to do with vehicles on a public highway. Is...in LB 291, were we trying to expand coverage to include also private roads to a certain extent? And I guess what my ultimate question is, will this provision correspond with LB 291 as it is? I guess I am questioning what the law is with regard to private roadways now, and I'd appreciate having my memory refreshed on that.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Senator Beutler, I believe that this bill just deals with on public roads, and I know that LB 291 does have a section in there that I believe does cover private driveways or private roads, but this is just public roads.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Just public roads, would it make sense to you to make the two bills correspond by the time we get through the end of the process?

SENATOR HEFNER: Senator Beutler, we can see if this bill advances and, let's see, LB 291 is on Select File, I believe, so we could certainly try to get an amendment so that they would be the same.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, and then just one more question, if I may, and I am not picking on your bill. I like the bill. The other part I had a question on was LB...was page 12, the paragraph at the top of the page that had to do with relevant evidence seem to apply only to prosecutions under state statute or city or village ordinances, and maybe I am also forgetting something here, but should it also apply to administrative proceedings or not? It is not relevant to that particular aspect of it.

SENATOR HEFNER: Senator Beutler, I don't believe this here bill does.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, thank you.
