

March 18, 1992 LB 1057, 1241

Nelson, do you wish to close on the advancement?

SENATOR NELSON: Nothing, thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: We will now vote on the advancement of LB 1057. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We're voting on the advancement of LB 1057. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 1057.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 1057 advances. We will now go to LB 1241.

CLERK: LB 1241, Mr. President, introduced by Senators Peterson, Dierks, Hefner, Wehrbein, and Schellpeper. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 22 of this year, at that time referred to Appropriations Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. Senator Peterson, would you like to go to your amendment, or explain....Do your amendment now, Senator?

SENATOR PETERSON: Okay.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Peterson.

CLERK: Senator Peterson has an amendment, Mr. President, found on page 1186 of the Journal. (See AM3153.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Peterson.

SENATOR PETERSON: Mr. President and members, this is an amendment that, in visiting with DAS, thought would make some clarification after the hearing on the bill. Number one, in cases where state agencies and other parties want to rent out state owned facilities, this bill will not apply to University of Nebraska, state colleges, and Department of Aeronautics, and Department of Roads, and the Board of Educational Lands and Funds because they have their own areas, where DAS would have the vacant buildings and everything else. These agencies are presently exempted from the Vacant Buildings and Excess Lands Act, and this bill would only continue those exemptions. Number two, the bill would not apply when it is...for facilities to be leased for use by the University of Nebraska, colleges and the Educational Lands and Funds, or in the case where the facilities are to be leased for nonoffice use by the Department of Roads.
