

Senator Dierks voting yes. Senator Lamb voting yes. Senator Lynch voting yes. Senator Beyer voting yes. Senator Rogers voting yes. Senator Schrock voting yes. Senator Byars voting yes. Senator Hefner voting yes. Senator Wehrbein voting yes.

SENATOR WARNER: Clerk, record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate.

SENATOR WARNER: Motion carried. Debate is ceased. Senator Baack, do you wish to close on the adoption of your amendment to the amendment?

SENATOR BAACK: Yes, Mr. Chairman, just very briefly. The amendment is not all that complex. The amendment simply makes some adjustments to make this bill match up with LB 529. The limitations that are in 529 we simply did not want two bills out there with different sets of limitations in. It also makes some changes that the accountability and disclosure brought to me relating to how the...clarifying which candidates qualify, which ones do not, when the public funds would be paid out to candidates and when they could file their affidavits as far as changing their estimates on their expenditures. That's all that this amendment does. I would urge its adoption. Thank you.
