

SENATOR CROSBY: Okay, and that is for primary and general combined. I'm sorry to keep saying that but I think that should...

SENATOR ASHFORD: No, that's combined.

SENATOR CROSBY: ...be very clear because we report differently and that would be...the only point about that is that the people who report and who work at that, the treasurers, are really going to have more of a job to be sure that those reports are done correctly when they are made. I am...I think I'll support this amendment because this goes back to the original 556, right, Senator Ashford?

SENATOR ASHFORD: Yes.

SENATOR CROSBY: That is what we had in the original thing and that is the call that I had from one of the members of the task force and I think she feels strongly and I think others do too that that was the original idea that it was going to limit not just expenditures, it was going to limit contributions because when you start figuring out a budget you don't necessarily figure out how much you might get, you try to figure out what you have to spend and then go from there, and Senator Chambers doesn't have to worry about that because he is just such a wonderful person and doesn't have to do all these things that the rest of us have...I couldn't resist, Senator Chambers. Anyway, yes, I thank you for bringing this amendment because I am going to vote for it because I do think that we do have to be very careful especially in legislative races because that's the one that I think is so close to state issues and we're close to our constituents and these people that do support and to the PACs, so I will support. I just wanted to be sure of that one particular part of it. Thank you.
