

offering to this amendment, putting in some specific intent. I also have a rough draft that I'm working on right now, an interim resolution, interim study resolution to address looking into the future of how we should deal with this. But, in essence, we now have an organization that we have chosen not to eliminate, but we have not included the funding specifically for this coming year out of the General Fund appropriation. So, what this amendment basically does is to reinstate the funding that was originally in...had been established that it was going to be necessary to fund them for this year. And, like I say, Senator Moore, I believe, is going to offer an amendment to that amendment shortly to make sure the intent is such that we serve notice that this is a one year situation. And during the interim we will have that study and try and find a more efficient, better way to deal with this agency's funding who has always, traditionally been under a cash fund basis. So the amendment, in essence, reinstates the \$27,185 out of the General Funds to assure that the funding will be there for them to operate this coming year.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Conway. Mr. Clerk, an amendment to the amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Moore would move to amend Senator Conway's amendment. (Moore amendment appears on page 1464 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: Mr. Speaker and members, as we continue the...what the three day discussion of the Athletic Commission, and as you know the first day Senator Conway offered this amendment, the body chose not to fund the Athletic Commission for the second year of the biennium. Yesterday I filed the motion to bring LB 1294 from committee, and that failed to get out of committee. And so we're kind of at a crossroads where something simply has to happen. If you're not willing to eliminate the agency, the proper thing to do is fund it. I guess this amendment tries to find a little middle ground so we can move forward. What this amendment simply does is it...I'll read it to you, it says that simply intent language in the bill. And it would say, it is the intent of the Legislature that no General Funds be appropriated to Agency 43, State Athletic Commissioner (sic), after fiscal year '92-93. And, basically, what that would say is Senator Conway's amendment would go ahead
