Technically, if you look at the green sheet right now you could...you would have no need to do this but you also would have no money left for any A bills or some other things that are still before you and it would be illogical it seems to me when those who proposed the amendment on 1063 said to the Legislature that they would have the whole package that we do not provide this mechanism so that we do not otherwise affect the budget in other areas. So I ask the amendment be adopted.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Wickersham had an amendment printed. I have a note that he wishes to withdraw, however. I have nothing further pending on the bill, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Does anyone else wish to address the bill itself? Seeing none, I'll recognize Senator Moore for closing.

SENATOR MOORE: I move the bill be advanced.

PRESIDENT MOUL: You've heard the motion to advance LB 1268. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of LB 1268.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 1268 is advanced. LB 1272.
