

Marques, \$600, Sherry Wolf for \$444 are all claims that arise from damage to personal property done by foster children in those homes, and from now on out, well, from 1992 forward, or late '91 and the rest of the time forward, claims of this type will be taken care of by the liability insurance package that is going to be provided to foster parents as part of their agreement with the Department of Social Services. So with that, I would encourage the adoption of the committee amendments. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Coordsen. Does anyone wish to address the committee amendments? Seeing none, we will now vote on the adoption of the committee amendments. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the adoption of the committee amendments? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The committee amendments are adopted. Senator Coordsen, for opening on the bill, itself.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Now the bill, itself, provides for the appropriation for a total of \$119,238.47 with the committee amendments attached; \$104,082.47 will come from Cash Funds, because most of the approved claims of the large amount are agency write-offs of bad checks, bad debts, and that sort of thing. The federal funds that are estimated are \$467.60. That is because of the involvement of the claims against the Department of Social Services and the mix of funding within that agency. The General Fund appropriation then is \$14,688.40. Any questions?
