SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Rod Johnson.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Mr. Speaker, members, again a technical amendment. If you're following the committee amendment package here, on page 5, I will read in the definition section of the bill that starts actually on page 4. It says, Section 10. Facilities shall mean any site owned and operated or utilized by any person for the collection source, separation, storage, transportation, transfer, processing, treatment or disposal of solid waste and shall include a solid waste landfill. And here's the critical language that we are offering to strike, "but shall not include a solid waste landfill". It's my understanding that this was just a bill drafting mistake because, obviously, it contradicts just what it says earlier in the sentence. So we would offer to strike on line 3 through line 4, "but shall not include a solid waste landfill". Again, I hope it's nothing more than a technical amendment that would resolve a slight mistake in drafting.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Rod Johnson. Anyone wishing to address this amendment? Senator Chambers, did you wish to address this amendment?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, I think I didn't get the page. Senator Johnson, where are you?

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Rod Johnson, would you respond, please.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Yes. Senator Chambers, it's...the language being stricken is on page 5, beginning on line 3 with the word "but" through line 4 to "landfill".

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I see it. Senator Johnson, you know this offers an opportunity for all kinds of things but I'm not going to do it. I think his amendment is reasonable.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Anyone else wishing to address this amendment? Seeing no one, Senator Rod Johnson, do you wish to close?

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Only to clarify again, as I was explaining to Senator Chambers, we're simply striking the language that is basically contradicting the terms in the sentence before it. So
