

we're simply striking "but shall not include a solid waste landfill". That's on line 3 and 4 of page 5 of the committee amendments. I would move for the adoption of this amendment to the committee amendments.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Rod Johnson. We will now vote on the amendment to the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 17 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the Johnson amendment to the committee amendments.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment to the committee amendments is adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Morrissey would move to amend. Senator, AM3566. (See page 1412 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Morrissey.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, and members, amendment 3566 is an amendment to the committee amendments. It discusses some of the compromises that we have made along the way in discussing this bill. I think I would still like to go one more time through the committee amendments, themselves, and as I get to the portion that relates to AM3566, I will explain it. The handout that I gave you that is basically a section by section summary of the bill and the committee amendments and AM3566. So Section 1 just names the act; Section 2, legislative findings; 3 through 16 are definitional sections, definitions for agency as a group, political subdivisions. They can go together to manage their solid waste, town with a town, city with a county, county with a county, NRD, across state lines, whatever seems to...whatever would work out best for waste streams and waste flows. County and municipal solid waste jurisdiction areas are fairly important definitions that we have in Section 3 through 16 and we have an amendment...no, we haven't amended that yet. But facility is defined, integrated solid waste management is defined. As we move through the process, we had the landfills staring us right in the face but yet we were trying to look long term at the total waste package so we wanted to make sure that the definitions of integrated solid waste include the reduction and recycling aspects of it, even though landfills are the most urgent right now, the long-term picture, we want to keep it out there looking long
