Let's say that there is an advertising firm in Omaha, then money goes out of this fund for them to advertise. Money can go out of this fund for any purpose that the politicians decide to call promoting of recycling. If you adopt this amendment, you are not in any way infringing the authority you gave Omaha to collect this fee. But what you are doing by adopting this amendment is to make sure that, under the guise of collecting a fee for the purpose of collecting and disposing of or recycling garbage and refuse, there is not additional money collected ostensibly for the purpose of promoting which can be used for anything. I hope you will adopt this amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. You've heard the closing on the amendment to the committee amendments offered by Senator Chambers. We'll now vote on that amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 12 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Chambers' amendment to the committee amendments.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment to the committee amendments is adopted.

SPEAKER BAACK: We are now on the committee amendments as they have been amended. Senator Rod Johnson.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Mr. Speaker and members, I would like to ask the Clerk, if he would, to divide the question on the committee amendments. And I have talked to the Clerk about this. I, basically, would like to divide the question relative to Sections 1 through 32. Take Section 33 by itself and Section 39 by itself, and the rest of the sections could be taken on their own. Specifically getting to the point, I would like to discuss the contents of, basically, Sections 33 and Sections 39, if that is divisible at that point.

SPEAKER BAACK: So you are asking for three divisions?
