

Wickersham.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Call the question.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Are there sufficient seconds? There are. We'll now vote on the motion to cease debate. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the motion to cease debate? Have you all voted? Senator Wickersham.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: I know it's close to the lunch hour, but I think we're well within the realm and ask for a call of the house and call-in votes.

PRESIDENT MOUL: We have a request for call of the house. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 18 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The house is under call. Would all unexcused senators please return to the Chamber and record your presence. All unauthorized personnel must leave the floor. The house is under call and we are accepting call-in votes on the motion to cease debate.

CLERK: Senator Warner voting no. Senator Labeledz voting yes.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Bernard-Stevens, Senator Beutler, Senator Lindsay, please check in. Senator Conway, Senator Coordsen, Senator Rasmussen, Senator Robak, please check in. Senator Hefner, Senator Lowell Johnson. We now have a request for a roll call vote. The house is under call. Would the senators please return to the Chamber and record your presence. Senator Lindsay, would you check in, please. We're looking for Senator Lowell Johnson and Senator Hefner, and Senator Schmit. Senator Wickersham, we're still looking. We'll proceed with roll call vote in reverse order.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 1598-99 of the Legislative Journal.) 23 ayes, 5 nays to cease debate.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Motion fails. I will raise the call. Do you have items for the record, Mr. Clerk?
