

SENATOR CHAMBERS: In a way. Let me say what I'm saying. You would make everything a part of the mediation process that you don't want to be available in the trial, whether it's by just letters or whether you write down what you want to present in the form of notes and submit it, but you get all that information into the process, yes. Then that cannot be reviewed by any court after that.

SENATOR ASHFORD: Okay. I am not certain that your amendment addresses that but I, for this...at this point, I'm going to go ahead and vote for Ernie's amendment, Senator Chambers' amendment, and then take a look at what he's doing. I think he may be right so we'll see, but I think you've made a point that I didn't catch and so there.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Ashford. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, I think Senator Ashford is doing the right thing, but I didn't want him to vote for the amendment. I didn't want him to accept it. Since they're insisting on passing this bill I wanted it to stay in there. My obligation, as I said, was to get that into the record. I'm not in a position to tell you don't vote for it now because I really think that you should, but, Senator Ashford, you threw me a curve that time. I was looking for a fast ball and I swung and I missed what you threw. But the rest of the members, I ask that you adopt the amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the closing on the amendment by Senator Chambers. We will now vote on the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 16 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Chambers' amendment to the committee amendments.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment to the amendment is adopted. Next amendment, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Lindsay...I have nothing further pending to the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: We are on the committee amendments now, as they have been amended. Is there discussion on the committee amendments? Senator Chambers, your light is on first.
