PRESIDENT MOUL PRESIDING

PRESIDENT MOUL: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain for today is Pastor Dr. Rod Wilmoth of St. Paul Methodist Church in Omaha, in Senator Will's district. Dr. Wilmoth.

That flood resulted in substantial loss of property and the loss of one life.
