PRESIDENT MOUL: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. The E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Madam President, the first amendment I have is by Senator Bernard-Stevens, AM3031, page 1057 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Bernard-Stevens.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Thank you, Madam President, members of the body. There was a group formed by the bill that set up an advisory commission to the person that would be selected as the individual who would come up with and present to the body and to the state a plan on juvenile justice. We just simply wanted to add to that commission a member from an advocacy group, to be selected by the Governor. And that's all...that's what the amendment does. It expands...expands the advisory commission to include an appointed member from an advocacy group.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Bernard-Stevens. Does anyone wish to address this amendment? Seeing none, we'll now vote on Bernard-Stevens...Senator Bernard-Stevens, you have closing.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Yes, thank you. Just in closing Senator Schimek asked a question, I wanted to make sure it was clarified. It does not specifically name any particular group, it's at the discretion of the Governor.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Bernard-Stevens. We'll now vote on the motion to adopt the Bernard-Stevens amendment. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment is adopted.
