SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: I don't see another senator here. We'll call the house and we'll accept roll call vote. Take the motion back.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Please record, Mr. Clerk.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Take the motion back.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of the amendment offered by Senator Bernard-Stevens.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Madam President, the only items I have remaining are the amendments by Senator Landis.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Is anyone prepared to address these amendments by Senator Landis? We'll proceed then, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Will, I have nothing further pending.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Madam President, I move the advancement of LB 447 to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: You've heard the motion to advance LB 447. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. LB 447 is advanced. LB 946.

CLERK: LB 946, Senator, I have no amendments. Senator Peterson would move to indefinitely postpone the bill, Madam President. Senator Coordsen would have the option to lay the bill over.
