empathize with your particular problem. But I think that we need to clear up the language so that there is no more confusion on this issue. Even in the Government Committee, which dealt with the redistricting matter, there was confusion among the members of the committee. So, while in sympathy, I am still going to vote against your motion to indefinitely postpone, Senator Peterson. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Schimek. Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Coordsen, if I may, I just wanted to correct your reference to Congressman Beutler. (Laughter.) I'm Beutler. It's Congressman Bereuter. And an easy way for you to remember that is that Bereuter rhymes with check writer, my name does not. (Laughter.) Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Senator Cudaback.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Madam President, members, I do agree with Senator Schimek, but at this time, I think I've had a major chan...as major a changes as anybody in this body. I represent 20,000 new people. We have told these people the circumstances, and Senator Schrock could not have been more gracious. He's taken me to the district, he's introduced me to the people, it's worked out great. We've told them what's going on, so I can't see adding more confusion. If we pass this bill the way that Senator Coordsen has it, I think it will make the situation more confusing and add to the problem. I think it should be changed, as Senator Schimek says, but let's do it next year or the year after. The damage has been done's been done. So, I think I would support the...Senator Peterson's motion to indefinitely postpone. Thank you.
