PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Rogers.

SENATOR ROGERS: Madam President, is that the E clause, Clerk?

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SENATOR ROGERS: I would like to pull the E clause. There is...evidently run into some problems, there is some EMTs that are in training, and that just isn't going to set in, so we want to withdraw that.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment is withdrawn. Further amendments, Mr. Clerk. Yes, the amendment is withdrawn.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Morrissey would move to amend. (See FA336 on page 1634 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Morrissey.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: Thank you, Madam President, and members. Mr. Clerk, would you please read that amendment?

CLERK: Senator, it reads amend 1138 to add a new section, which would read, the Department of Health shall promulgate the rules and regulations to implement this act by September 1, 1992.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: Thank you. The intent, members, was to get the department right after passage of this bill to start working on rules and regs so we can have it in effect. On passage, we will be agreeing that it is needed, and we want the department to start immediately working on promulgating the rules and regs so the bill will be able to be carried out, the mandate be carried out by the volunteers as soon as possible upon the effective date of the bill. So I urge your support.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Morrissey. Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: I would rise in support of this as well. We have had trouble with the Department of Health, Senator Conway has had problems, and other people have had problems with years going by before rules and regs were adopted. We just found, for instance, a 1987 bill we passed on immunizations in day care
