

you think there is problems, and I have to agree with you and with Senator Beutler that there are some problems with it, yes, it was drafted parochially, with some of the interest in hand, which is basically what we do with a lot of bills. But since I will not be here another year, if you bracket it until the 16th, basically I will be gone. Do you want to carry on with this, since I think in your heart you believe that something needs to be done? You just don't think that this is the right particular bill.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Beyer, what I had said is that we should have a study and that I would participate in the study, and I would like the legislators to be aware that I have said that, so that when the study is put together, I will be made a member, and I will work to draft legislation. And that is not to say that it will be drafted in the way this one was where the people who are in the industry want certain things, and I would draft everything that they want. I won't promise that in advance.

SENATOR BEYER: Well, I didn't ask that.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But I will participate in the study and I will work toward putting together some appropriate legislation. But I can't tell you right this minute what all that legislation would consist of, but I will work on the study, if the Legislature will authorize one, and then I would participate in the putting together of legislation.

SENATOR BEYER: Do you believe that something is needed?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Without question, that is why I don't want to just put a kill motion on the bill because that would be perceived as saying that the idea of regulation is not needed. I am not against the idea of regulation, and I am not criticizing your intent to regulate. I am just saying that the bill before us is not suitable, and as many things as I see wrong with it, I don't think it should be... I don't think there is any way to rewrite it, in other words, at this time, to make it a proper comprehensive regulation of an entire industry, when most of us on the floor know very little about the industry, and I am including myself in that. But I only say most of us because some who have not spoken may know a great deal about it, but they are just not sharing with us their knowledge.
