CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of Senator Bernard-Stevens' amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Bernard-Stevens.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: I'd simply move the advancement of the A bill.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Bernard-Stevens. Does anyone wish to speak to the bill, itself? Seeing none, we will now vote on the motion to advance LB 447A. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the motion to advance the bill.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 447A is advanced. LB 556A.

CLERK: LB 556A introduced by Senator Baack. (Read title.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Speaker Baack.

SPEAKER BAACK: Yes, Madam President and colleagues, this is another one of the bills, we have got a number of them that are on General File that need to catch up with the bills that are on Select File. This one appropriates \$50,000 to the Campaign Finance Limitation Cash Fund, with the Accountability and Disclosure Commission, and that 50,000 would go into the fund in '93-94, and then it also appropriates 21,000 from the General Fund for '92-93 for an increased...they are saying that they have to have another person or two to take care of this campaign limitation up in the Accountability Commission, so this would be a half a year's salary, and then it would appropriate \$41,220 for the next full year, '93-94, and with that I would be happy
