PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further pending on the bill.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: I would move for advancement of the bill.

PRESIDENT MOUL: You've heard the motion to advance LB 1006. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. LB 1006 is advanced. LB 1006A.

CLERK: LB 1006A, no E & R. Senator Wesely has an amendment pending, Madam President. AM3797, Senator. (See pages 1730-31 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you, Madam President, and members. This authorizes the cash funds that would be raised from the previous amendment dealing with an increase in the fees assessed on self-insureds under workers' comp. It would provide for an appropriation of \$63,858 from the cash fund for fiscal year, '92-93, and 53,618 from that cash fund for '93-94 to the workers' comp court so that they could go forward and adequately review self-insurance workers' comp plans and approve new ones, and I would ask for adoption of this amendment to LB 1006A.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Wesely. Is there anyone who wishes to address this amendment? Seeing none, we will now vote on the motion to adopt the Wesely amendment. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of Senator Wesely's amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Senator Rasmussen would move to amend the bill, Madam President. (See AM3494 on page 1731 of the Legislative Journal.)
