SENATOR ABBOD: Okay, so is this bill...is this bill...I take it this bill is not exactly as was amended when it was brought out on the floor?

SENATOR PIRSCH: No.

SENATOR ABBOD: Or of LB 104?

SENATOR PIRSCH: No, that is correct. It is as was passed out to you on the floor, as I understand.

SENATOR ABBOD: Which sections of the committee amendments were taken out?

SENATOR PIRSCH: Well, the sign was the only thing taken out. We put into different verbiage the 300 feet and the ten days notice before the planning board meeting and, essentially, all that...

SENATOR ABBOD: Okay, would you mind if I...

SENATOR PIRSCH: ...was changed which was the sign, notification by the property owner.

SENATOR ABBOD: Okay, would you mind if I asked you...I will go through the committee amendments here. I am trying to determine what is, in fact, left in the bill, then? Is the section dealing with the employee liability section, Section 1, provides that the city and its employees are not liable for any damages to any person resulting from failure to provide the notice required by this section, is that still in the bill?

SENATOR PIRSCH: Yes...

SENATOR ABBOD: Okay.

SENATOR PIRSCH: If you will remember, I think my language was a good faith effort and that was difficult to...

SENATOR ABBOD: So that is still in the bill? Section 4, provides, no zoning decision by the city council is void, invalidated or affected in any way by the irregularity, defect, error, or failure on the part of the city or its employees in
