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you know that. Article V of the compact, Section 2, subsection (f), the preliminary selection or selections made by the commission...

SPEAKER BAACK: One minute.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: ...pursuant to this Article shall become final and receive the commission's approval. If the proposed facility fails to become licensed, the commission shall make another selection pursuant to the procedures identified in this Article. And if you know what this Article is, that means they go back and even select another developer. Rich Paton, US Ecology, in Natural Resources Committee, on the record said we start over. We go back to phase 1. We start over. We could even go so far as to selecting a new developer, a new state. It might not happen that way, but that is how it goes. There is no chaos, if the vote is rejected, just like there is no chaos if the site is rejected. It is all a bogus argument brought to you courtesy of the out-of-state power companies that are trying to hand off to those citizens that you have an obligation to look out for, they are trying to hand off their liability on millions of dollars worth of waste that they made profit on. And that is your obligation, and I'd urge you to consider that...

SPEAKER BAACK: Time.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: ...because that is the solid truth.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Morrissey. Senator Dierks, you are next.

SENATOR DIERKS: I'd call the question, please.

SPEAKER BAACK: The question has been called. Do I see five hands? I do. We will now vote on ceasing debate. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on ceasing debate, have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to cease debate.

SPEAKER BAACK: Debate has ceased. I will go to Senator Beutler to close on your amendment.
