SENATOR WARNER: Seeing no other lights, the motion is the approval of the confirmation report. Those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Clerk, record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the confirmation report.

SENATOR WARNER: Motion's carried and the confirmation report is approved. Mr. Clerk, are there items on the desk?

CLERK: Mr. President, thank you. I have an explanation of vote from Senator Labeledz. Your Committee on Judiciary, whose Chair is Senator Chizek, to whom was referred LB 78 respectfully reports the same back to the Legislature with a recommendation it be advanced to General File; LR 222 advanced to General File, both signed by Senator Chizek, as Chair of the committee. SENATOR WARNER: Senator Horgan has guests this morning. Well, they're just coming in. We'll hold it up. LB 573, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion with respect to LB 573. Senator Baack would move to return LB 573 to Select File for a specific amendment. The amendment is found on page 669 of the Journal.

SENATOR WARNER: Senator Baack.

SENATOR BAACK: Yes, Mr. Chairman and colleagues, if you remember on... I need this motion to return 573 for a specific amendment and on Select File we did make an amendment on this bill that, under the old system, the Policy Research Office used to review the plans by NRDs and we took that out because they no longer do that. They no longer look... the Legislature's allowed the NRDs more authority over the years so PRO was taken out of that process.
