council, these development districts would review plans by NRDs. That is not being done now and there is no reason for them to do that because the NRDs have their own authority and there is no reason for these development councils to review their plans. So this just takes out the rest of that language and allows the NRDs the authority that we've given them over the years and they do not have to have their plans reviewed by these development districts. So, with that, I would ask you to return the bill for this specific amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR WARNER: Seeing no further lights, the motion is to return LB 573 to Select File for the specific amendment. Those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Clerk, record.
