SENATOR HABERMAN: That, but it's given to the Department of Revenue and they're to use it for that purpose. Is that correct?

SENATOR HABERMAN: What is the 85,800 dollars for that's given to the Department of Revenue?

SENATOR HABERMAN: Okay. All right, so what we're saying then is to put 1063 into effect for two years it's going to cost roughly 200,000 dollars. Is that correct?

SENATOR WARNER: Yes.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Well, 95.5 and 85.8 is...

SENATOR HABERMAN: ..185,000 dollars.

SENATOR WARNER: Approximately, 200.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Now and also does it say that the aid to counties is reduced from 13.5 for 1992-93 and it's reduced from 17 million for '91-92? That such aid shall be also...

SENATOR HABERMAN: ..13.5 for '93-94?

SENATOR WARNER: It's reduced 13...three and a half million...

SPEAKER BAACK: One minute.

SENATOR WARNER: ..for '92-93. No change for '91-92.

SENATOR HABERMAN: So it is reducing the state aid to counties,
