SENATOR WARNER: That is correct.

SENATOR HABERMAN: In the amount of 13,500,000 for '92-93.

SENATOR WARNER: No, no.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Is that correct?

SENATOR WARNER: No, the reduction is three and a half million.

SENATOR HABERMAN: It's reducing the aid to counties three and a half million...

SENATOR WARNER: Correct.

SENATOR HABERMAN: ..for '92-93.

SENATOR WARNER: Correct.

SENATOR HABERMAN: And then it's reducing for '91-92, 17 million?

SENATOR WARNER: No, no reduction for '91.

SENATOR HABERMAN: No reduction.

SENATOR WARNER: Ninety...17 million, Senator Haberman, is the total appropriation for '91-92. The total appropriation for '92-93 is 13.5 million, or a three and a half million reduction for that year.

SENATOR HABERMAN: So we're saying a 13,500,000 for '93-94?

SENATOR WARNER: That will be the level of appropriation.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Okay.

SPEAKER BAACK: Time. Senator Morrissey, you're next.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members. Senator Warner, if you would, please. On the estimates on the fiscal note for 1063 on the fertilizer tax, when they ran those estimates were they including compost in the estimates?
