SENATOR ROGERS: I'd like to advance the bill to E & R.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the motion to advance LB 366. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is advanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Rogers would move to return the bill. Senator, you pick.

SENATOR ROGERS: 3837.

CLERK: 3837, yes, sir.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Rogers.

SENATOR ROGERS: AM3837 is another housekeeping measure needed by the Department of Ag. This is to keep its regulations of weighing and measuring devices current. This amendment incorporates LB 959, which we heard in Ag Committee, was reported out without any amendments. It updates the Weight and Measures Act by adopting some of the handbooks published by the National Institute of Standards of Technology, and it also revises inspection and reservation fees. There have been no increase, I think, since 1983 or 4, the fee is increased from like \$1 to \$4. Would ask for the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: Okay, we are voting on a motion to return the bill for a specific amendment. We will now vote on that motion. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: The bill is returned. To the amendment, Senator Rogers.

SENATOR ROGERS: Just ask for the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: Seeing no discussion, we will vote on the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.
