SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is adopted. Would you like to readvance the bill, Senator Rogers.

SENATOR ROGERS: I move to readvance the bill to E & R.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the motion to readvance. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is advanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Rogers would move to return the bill for specific amendment, AM3838, Senator.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Rogers.

SENATOR ROGERS: Mr. Speaker and members, this is another amendment. This bill was 961, we heard it in the Ag Committee, there was no opposition. It updates several laws under their jurisdiction, has something to do with the Department of Health, Human Services of pasteurized milk. This would include an emergency clause with an operative date of July 1, 1992 for the pasteurized milk changes, and this is the date that the pasteurized milk federal guidelines, when they go into effect. And I would move to return the bill for this amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: We are on the motion to return. Is there any discussion? Seeing none, we will vote on that motion. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the motion to return the bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: The motion is adopted, the bill has been returned. We are on the amendment. Senator Rogers.

SENATOR ROGERS: Mr. Speaker, and members, this is another bill from the Department of Agriculture to update several of their laws. This includes LB 961, which we heard in Ag Committee. Got some more to do with the pasteurized milk law, as I mentioned. And part of this is to be in compliance with a federal law that goes into effect July 1, 1992, and I ask for its adoption.

SPEAKER BAACK: Any discussion? Seeing none, we will vote on the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.
