SPEAKER BAACK: Do you have items for the record?

CLERK: Mr. President your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports they have carefully examined and reviewed LB 988 and recommend that same be placed on Select File; LB 447A, LB 556A, LB 1241A, LB 529A all on Select File. That's all that I have, Mr. President. (See pages 1812-13 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER BAACK: We will now proceed to Item 10 on the agenda with Select File and LB 1022.

CLERK: Mr. President, 1022, first order of business is consideration of Enrollment and Review amendments.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Moore, you want to move the E & R amendments.

SENATOR MOORE: I move the E & R amendments to LB 1022 be adopted.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Moore, as Chairman of Appropriations, would move amendment AM3749. (Moore amendment appears on page 1660 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: Mr. Speaker and members, it's Journal page 1660. If you want to look on Journal page 1660, and also the Pages are distributing an explanation of this series of amendments that the Appropriations Committee has recommended, a Select File amendment to LB 1022, there are actually 12 sections to this amendment. And as you can look in the summary what the 12 items are. The only...the two...well two of them have General Fund impact for the present fiscal year we're in, the rest of them are a variety of, with one exception, well the total General Fund impact is \$103,000 for the fiscal year we are now in; the impact for next year is roughly \$98,000. I'll quickly go through the 12 items. The first is simple intent language. In the Department of Health there are some new federal requirements, and there are some...at least there is some intent
