talked with Senator Schrock and we both agree that our amendment would probably not be appropriate to LB 1022. Also talked to Senator Moore, he agrees. But it would be a vehicle that could be used, that's not being used now, that could raise some funds and in fact offer some stability. So what, with Senator Schrock's permission, I would like to do is to respectfully withdraw this amendment and we will immediately begin a search for the appropriate vehicle. But trust that we will offer this amendment at the appropriate time. And rather than taking the time of the body to go into the details of it, with everything that we have to do it would be inappropriate. And so at this point in time we would withdraw this amendment, Madam Chairman.
