PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Hall. I will rule that it is divisible. Senator Hartnett, which of the sections would you like to take up first?

SENATOR HARTNETT: Let's take this section. Senator Hall, I think you need Section 12 because I think that references, probably need section...talks about in Section 12 and 14 if you're going to divide that, and 15. Do you see that, Senator Hall?

SENATOR HALL: Okay, sure, Paul, you're absolutely right. Yes, Mr. Clerk, I apologize, it would be both Sections 12 and 14. The only portion of Section 12 that touches on it is where it says that last two lines, but it does need to...I do agree with Senator Hartnett and the two would have to go together. So I would ask that Section 12 and 14 on pages 1600 and 1601 of the amendment as it appears in the Journal be separated and then the balance of the amendment be the second half. They can be taken in whatever order, Madam President, that Senator Hartnett prefers.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Hall. Which section would you prefer?

SENATOR HARTNETT: Madam President, just the one that Senator Hall has mentioned there, the first one.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Okay.

SENATOR HARTNETT: The three times 270, I think.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Okay, we'll take that section up first then. Senator Hall, do you want to continue to address this?

SENATOR HALL: I would like to. Thank you, Madam President and members, I rise to oppose this portion of the Hartnett amendment to LB 1240.
